OPINION

LESKINEN, P.J.

August 30, 2023

Before the Court is the Defendant's Omnibus Pretrial Motion in the form of a Motion to Suppress. The Defendant asserts that the Trooper had no probable cause for the traffic stop. The Defendant was charged with Driving Under the Influence, 75 Pa. C.S. § 3802(A)(1), Disregard Traffic Lane-Single, 75 Pa. C.S. § 3309 (1); and Temporary Registration Card Violation, 75 Pa. C.S. 1310(A). The Court viewed the Motor Vehicle Recording (hereinafter "MVR") in making its determination in this case.

BACKGROUND

On January 2, 2022 at 2:26 A.M., the Troopers began following a burgundy Chevrolet Cobalt traveling in the right lane. The Troopers' MVR displayed the following:

The burgundy Cobalt traveled in front of the Trooper's marked vehicle for a significant distance. No other vehicles were present on the roadway. It was a dark area of roadway with and just a couple of large, illuminated business areas. The roadway was wet and it was raining as the officers followed the vehicle. During the time the Troopers followed the vehicle, the Defendant's vehicle never traveled outside her lane. The Defendant's vehicle did at one point touch the fog line on the right side of her lane, but did not cross over it. The Defendant's vehicle drove entirely in her lane for the entire MVR recording. The MVR records one Trooper's statement that she was traveling twenty-five (25) miles per hour and then thirty-five (35) miles per hour. It was not clear from the recording what the speed of the Defendant's vehicle actually was, but the Troopers' vehicle seemed to have slowed. The Defendant used her turn signals, and turned to the right into a gas station. As she made her right turn, one Trooper is heard commenting that the temporary vehicle registration was not in the proper location in the rear window of the vehicle. At the time of the stop, the Trooper questioned the Defendant if she was having car trouble and commented that her temporary registration was in the wrong location and was coming loose from the window.

DISCUSSION

The Defendant asserts that the Trooper had no probable cause to stop the vehicle as a "momentary and minor" violation of the Vehicle Code is not sufficient.

The Defendant operated her vehicle only in her lane throughout the time the Troopers were following her vehicle. There were no other vehicles on the highway which was a very dark stretch of roadway, and wet from rain. There was some movement of the Defendant's vehicle in her lane of travel but not such that one could draw the conclusion that she was impaired. The vehicle touched the white center line and the white line on the right but never drove over either line.

Section 3364 of the Motor Vehicle Code, Minimum speed regulation states that "Except when reduced speed is necessary for safe operation or in compliance with law, no person shall drive a motor vehicle at such a slow speed as to impede the normal and reasonable movement of traffic." 75 Pa. C.S. § 3364.


In the charge of Driving on roadways laned for traffic, Section 3309(1) "Driving within single lane.-A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practicable entirely within a single lane and shall not be moved from the lane until the driver has first ascertained that the movement can be made safely." 75 Pa. C.S. § 3309.

There was no safety concern based on the circumstances in this case. Commonwealth v. Lana, 832 A.2d 527 (Pa. Super. 2003). There was no violation of the above two sections of the Vehicle Code. The Trooper also charged her at Section1310(a) which permits the issuance of temporary registration cards. Obviously, there was no violation of that section, as she had the required temporary registration card. The comment on the MVR concerning the alleged misplacement of the Temporary Registration in her back window did not clearly set forth a violation of any other section. The Trooper did not charge her with a violation of Section 1310.1(c), and it is not apparent that there was a violation of that section. That section provides that: "Except as otherwise provided, a registration permit shall be affixed to the extreme lower left-hand (driver's side) inside corner of the rear window of a vehicle with the printed information visible from the outside." There was no evidence showing an illegal placement of the permit, which was read by the Troopers from the outside without difficulty.

Based on the circumstances presented, the Troopers lacked probable cause to stop the vehicle, the evidence obtained from the stop is suppressed and the Defendant's motion is granted.
