# PBA Judicial Evaluation Commission Issues Ratings for Judicial Candidates

In just a few weeks, voters will be selecting candidates seeking election to the state's appellate courts in November. Candidates are seeking to fill one seat on the Superior Court and one seat on the Commonwealth Court.

The Pennsylvania Bar Association Judicial Evaluation Commission recently issued its ratings for all appellate judge candidates appearing on the May 17 primary ballots.

Each candidate seeking to fill a vacancy and requesting an evaluation by the PBA JEC is eligible to receive a rating of "Highly Recommended," "Recommended" or "Not Recommended." The commission's ratings are:

Superior Court of Pennsylvania — Highly Recommended, Judge David N. Wecht, Allegheny County; Recommended, Judge Paula A. Patrick, Philadelphia County; and Victor P. Stabile, Dauphin County.

Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania — <u>Highly Recommended</u>, Judge Paul P. Panepinto, Philadelphia County; <u>Recommended</u>, Kathryn Boockvar, Bucks County, and Anne E. Covey, Bucks County; <u>Not Recommended</u>, Barbara Behrend Ernsberger, Allegheny County (for failure to participate in evaluation process).

The PBA JEC based its ratings for each candidate on a two-part evaluation process. Investigative panels conducted the first phase of the process, which included personal interviews with the candidates and with individuals who have had professional or personal dealings with them. Upon completion of the investigative process, the panels submitted confidential reports to the commission. After reviewing the investigative panels' reports, the commission interviewed each candidate in Harrisburg, discussed his or her qualifications and reached consensus on each candidate's rating.

"The PBA JEC provides information to help voters choose candidates best suited to serve as fair, impartial and knowledgeable judges," said Pittsburgh lawyer Chris F. Gillotti, chairperson of the PBA JEC. "By its own definitions, the PBA JEC only recommends potential candidates with the legal ability, experience, integrity and temperament to provide satisfactory or outstanding performance as judges on our appellate benches."
