RECENT OPINION SUMMARIES

Baker v. Wolrpel Trucking, Inc. v. Gavern, A.D. 10-10992 (2012)

In order to sustain a claim that a vehicle driver was negligent in failing to provide sufficient warning to other drivers of debris on the road, the Plaintiff must produce evidence that Defendant knew or should have known there was debris on the highway and then failed to warn approaching drivers of the hazard. Keefer v. Cafaro, F.C. 05-90806-D (2011) In making an award of equitable distribution, the Court shall consider the situation and assets of the parties at the time of distribution and not at the time immediately prior to the death of one of the parties.

Duckstein v. Schrecengost, A.D. 03-1005 (2011)

In determining damages, the fact-finder must assess the testimony, by weighing the evidence and determining its credibility, and by accepting or rejecting the estimates of the damages given by the witnesses. Although justice and public policy require that the wrongdoer bear the risk of Imcertainty which his own wrong has created and which prevents precise computation of damages, the fact finder still may not render a verdict based on speculation or guesswork.

JRAD Ventures, LLC v. Jackson Township Zoning Hearing Board, A.D. 11-10643 (2012)

According to 53 P.S. § 11003-A.(d), a court appeal from a land use decision does not automatically stay the decision from which the appeal is taken, although the appellants may petition for the court for a stay; however, the statute provides that only an appel/ant in a land use appeal has the ability to petition for a stay.

Kelly v. PPR Realty, Inc., et al., A.D. 11-1 0388 (2011)

Innocent misrepresentation of material fact claims have been used to cancel real estate transactions in situations where the transaction itself was based on misrepresentation; however, there are no cases in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania wherein the court has allowed an innocent misrepresentation to constitute the basis to award monetary damages to a Plaintiff.

Meredith v. Steel Dynamics, Inc. et al, A.D. 11-10554 (2012)

A state may exercise in personam jurisdiction over a nonresident defendant based either upon the specific acts of the defendant that gave rise to the cause of action or upon the defendant's general activity within the state. In order for a Pennsylvania court to assert specific jurisdiction, the cause of action must arise out of the defendant's particular acts or activities within Pennsylvania. General jurisdiction, on the other hand, exists regardless of whether the cause of action is related to the defendant's activities in the Commonwealth, as long as the defendant's activities are continuous and substantial, or continuous and systematic.

Narmini v. Jackson Township, et al, A.D. 07-10797 (2011)

Under the Pennsylvania Political Subdivision Tort Claims Act, a local agency, or an employee thereof, acting within the scope of his office or duties, shall not "be liable for any damages on account of any injury to a person or property caused by any act of the local agency or an employee or any other person." Moreover, local agencies are not liable for injuries caused by their own acts or the acts of their employees that constitute a "crime, actual fraud, malice, or willful misconduct." 42 Pa.C.S.A. § 8542(a).

Sieminski v. Monongahela Power Co., Et. Al., A.D. 08-12265 (2012)

In the absence of direct evidence, the opinion of an expert is not sufficient to create a genuine issue of material fact to overcome summary judgment. Failure of a non-moving party to adduce sufficient evidence on an issue essential to his case and on which it bears the burden of proof ... establishes the entitlement of the moving party to judgment as a matter of law.

Winteres v. NVR, Inc. tla Ryan Homes, A.D. 09-11572 (2012)

The inclusion of a disclaimer in a document that the document is an estimate only and not a warranty upon which a negligent misrepresentation claim is based contradicts a plaintiff's assertion of justifiable reliance on representations within said document.


