SUMMARY OF OPINION:

In this motor vehicle litigation, plaintiffs asserted negligence and recklessness claims against a motorist and her employer and sought to recover compensatory and punitive damages. The punitive damages claims were based upon the pre-trial reports of plaintiffs' accident reconstruction expert, who opined that: (1) based upon the "sight distance available" at the subject intersection, the employee acted with "reckless indifference as defined in the Standard Jury Instruction" when she failed to yield the right-of- way to the male plaintiff and made a left-hand turn in front of his oncoming vehicle; and (2) the employer's failure to properly investigate this collision and/or conduct "a reliable root cause analysis" constituted "reckless conduct." The employer and employee filed a motion for partial summary judgment seeking to dismiss the punitive damages claims on the grounds that the competent evidence was insufficient as a matter of law to sustain the claims of recklessness.

There was no evidence in the record that the employee was speeding, driving while impaired or distracted by cellphone use, or otherwise engaged in unreasonable conduct manifesting conscious disregard of a known or obvious risk posing a high probability of harm to others. The proper operation of a motor vehicle concerns a matter within the common knowledge of the average layperson, and does not involve some science, profession, industry, or occupation requiring the specialized skill, experience, or education of an expert witness. Based upon the untechnical facts surrounding the occurrence of this run-of-the-mill intersectional collision, plaintiffs' expert could not express the legal opinion that the employee was chargeable with "reckless indifference," as defined by Pennsylvania law, particularly since the record did not contain an adequate basis for that opinion. Therefore, the motion for partial summary judgment was granted as to the punitive damages claim against the employee.

Punitive damages are designed to punish a tortfeasor for outrageous conduct and to deter the tortfeasor and others from similar conduct and require the fact-finder to consider the nature and extent of the harm to the plaintiff that the tortfeasor caused or intended to cause. The employer's post-accident investigation of this collision did not cause or contribute to the occurrence of the accident or the harm that plaintiffs claimed to have suffered. As such, the employer's after-the-fact investigation of this accident could not serve as the basis for plaintiff's punitive damages claim, and due to the absence of any other evidence in the record of the employer's willful, wanton, or reckless conduct, the employer's motion for partial summary judgment with respect to the punitive damages was also granted.

SUMMARY OF OPINION:

Plaintiff filed this personal injury action after he lost control of his Honda scooter and crashed into a guiderail allegedly due to loose gravel and other material on the roadway from milling and application of a high friction surface to the roadway. Plaintiff sued PennDOT and the construction project prime contractor, subcontractor, and inspector, but used the generic term "defendants" throughout the complaint without identifying which named defendants were being accused of what acts of negligence. Defendants' original preliminary objections under Rule 1028(a)(3) were sustained and plaintiff was directed to file an amended complaint.

The amended complaint likewise failed to set forth self-sufficient separate counts against each defendant delineating the individuals causes of action against them, and defendants filed preliminary objections which again challenged the factual specificity of the complaint. By lumping all four defendants into a single negligence count setting forth identical allegations as to each defendant, the amended complaint failed to provide defendants with notice of the claims against which they had to defend, particularly since it could not be alleged that the defendants, which all had distinct job responsibilities, committed the exact same negligent conduct. Therefore, although the preliminary objections were sustained, plaintiff was afforded a final opportunity to sufficiently identify each cause of action being advanced against each named defendant in a separate count by filing a second amended complaint to that effect.
