OPINION

Linda R. Cordaro, J. February 16, 2022

SUMMARY

Currently before this Court is an Amended Petition to Set Aside the Proposed Schedule of Distribution for the tax sale that is the subject of Case No. 1545 of 2014 G.D. The Petitioner, Tomas Phillips, was the highest bidder at the tax sale for the property and purchased it in 2014. The original schedule of distribution proposed by the Fayette County Tax Claim Bureau in 2014 showed a balance of \$12,177.26 to be paid to Candace Hill, the delinquent owner. Petitioner now asks this Court to set the schedule aside and refund the balance to him instead.

BACKGROUND

On June 9, 2014, the property at 401 Johnston Avenue (ID number 05-06-0136) was subject to a free and clear tax sale. Candace Hill, the delinquent owner, originally filed exceptions and objections to the sale and petitioned for it to be set aside. (No. 1545 of 2014 G.D.) Tomas Phillips, the purchaser of the subject property, was an intervenor on the case.

On November 14, 2014, the Honorable Joseph M. George, Jr. ordered that Ms. Hill had 30 days in which to pay all delinquent taxes and interest on the subject premises, all direct costs of notice of the sale, plus a pro-rated portion of the advertising. If Ms. Hill complied, then the Fayette County Tax Bureau was ordered to refund all monies paid by the highest bidder. If Ms. Hill failed to comply, then the Bureau was to issue a deed to the highest bidder.

Ms. Hill did not pay the required funds by the deadline. On January 20, 2015, Tomas Phillips filed a motion to distribute proceeds from the tax sale so that the balance of funds remaining after deducting costs, taxes, and liens would be refunded to him. On January 22, 2015, Ms. Hill filed her own motion to distribute the proceeds to her "as the record owner at the time the sale took place." At that time, the schedule prepared by the Fayette County Tax Claim Bureau proposed a distribution to Ms. Hill of \$12,177.26, the balance remaining after costs, taxes, and liens were deducted from the final bid price of \$20,000 paid by Tomas Phillips.

Both motions were withdrawn without prejudice according to a January 28, 2015 Order after "consideration of the statements made by counsel for all parties in open court and there being no objection." No further actions on No. 1545 of 2014 have been recorded.

On December 13, 2021, Mr. Phillips obtained a default judgment for quiet title of the property. (No. 1335 of 2021 G.D.)

Mr. Phillips now argues that because he is the person whose name last appears on the deed of the property, he is the "owner" of the property as defined by 72 Pa.C.S.A. § 5860.102. As this is the case, and as Ms. Hill has abandoned the property and did not respond to his quiet title action, she has no interest in the property, and Mr. Phillips is entitled to the proceeds of the tax sale.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner cites to the definition section of 72 Pa.C.S.A. § 5860 as support for his argument. The definitions set forth by 72 Pa.C.S.A. § 5860.102 as to real estate tax sales state that an "owner" is "the person in whose name the property is last registered" or "whose name last appears as an owner of record on any deed or instrument of conveyance recorded in the county office "Section 5860.102 also defines a "delinquent property owner" using identical language: one "whose taxes on the subject property are delinquent and in whose name the property is last registered" or "whose name last appears as an owner of record on a deed or instrument of conveyance recorded in the county office...."

Two individuals on opposite sides of a real estate purchase transaction cannot simultaneously be the "last registered" person on a deed. Either the "owner" is the one whose property is being sold or the "owner" is the one that purchases the property. Since the purchaser cannot be delinquent on taxes for a property he does not (yet) own, it is entirely reasonable that the "delinquent property owner" is the one whose property is being sold, i.e., the "last registered" on the deed. Because § 5860.102 uses identical language to define an "owner," it follows that the "owner" is not the purchaser, but the one whose property is being sold.

Clearly, in this case, Ms. Hill was the owner at the time of the tax sale. Petitioner's argument is unpersuasive that because he now is the last registered name on the deed, he therefore is the "owner" for purposes of distribution of proceeds of the sale. Petitioner's name is only on the deed now as a result of the tax sale itself and the transaction was based on his bid of \$20,000.

If, as Petitioner argues, the purchaser at a tax sale is entitled to the remainder of the proceeds of the sale, then there would be no need for a bidding process. The purchase price of any tax sale property would always equal the delinquency amount. Such a scheme would deprive delinquent owners of any monetary value in exchange for their properties.

Finally, under 72 P.S. § 5860.205(f):

Whenever no claim for payment of any balance due the owner of the property is presented by or on behalf of the owner within a period of three (3) years of the date of the sale, the balance of the proceeds shall be distributed to the respective taxing districts pro rata based on the millage imposed by the respective taxing districts as of the year such property was sold. Interest earned by the proceeds of the sale during this three-year period shall be retained by the county.

Petitioner did timely file a motion to distribute proceeds in January 2015, but the motion was withdrawn. Thereafter, he did not file another petition until January 15, 2021, over six (6) years after the sale.

Therefore, even if this Court were to find that Petitioner is the owner of the property for distribution purposes, the January 2021 filing is untimely, and he would not be entitled to claim the funds now.

ORDER

AND NOW, this 18th day of February, 2022, in consideration of the Amended Petition to Set Aside Distribution, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that:

- (1) The Petition of Tomas Phillips is hereby DENIED.
- (2) Within fifteen (15) days of this Order, the Fayette County Tax Claim Bureau shall make all reasonable efforts to notify Candace Hill of the balance remaining from the sale of 401Johnston Avenue (ID number 05-06-1036). The Bureau shall provide proof that service was effected upon Ms. Hill herself or proof that such service was attempted.
