2. Friendship Village of Bloomington life care retirement community, owned and operated by the Borrower, located at 8100 Highwood Drive, Bloomington, Minnesota, and including 295 independent living apartments, 12 town homes, 66 skilled nursing beds and a 53-bed boarding care center. The Friendship Village of Bloomington Project is expected to include the construction of a new building for 42 assisted living beds and 32 memory support beds, construction of 108 senior living apartments, and remodeling, renovating, improving and equipping said facility in the approximate amount of \$7,475,000.

3. Friendship Village of South Hills life care retirement community, owned and operated by the Borrower, located at 1290 Boyce Road, Upper St. Clair, Pennsylvania 15241, and including 282 independent living apartments, 20 Carriage Homes and 89 skilled nursing beds. The Friendship Village of South Hills Project is expected to include the construction of a new building for 52 assisted living beds and 32 memory support beds, and remodeling, renovating, improving and equipping said facility in the approximate amount of \$31,725,000.

4. Oak Trace life care retirement community, owned and operated by the Borrower, located at 200 Village Drive, Downers Grove, Illinois, and including independent living apartments and villas and skilled nursing beds. The Oak Trace Project is expected to include the construction of a new building for 66 assisted living beds, 28 memory support beds and 102 skilled nursing beds, and remodeling, renovating, improving and equipping said facility in the approximate amount of \$32,100,000.

5. Village on the Green life care retirement community, owned and operated by the Borrower, located at 500 Village Place, Longwood, Florida, and including 244 independent living apartments and villas and

60 skilled nursing beds. The Village on the Green Project is expected to include remodeling, renovating, improving and equipping said facility in the approximate amount of \$11,235,000.

Bond proceeds in the approximate amount of \$29,350,000 will be used refund the Series 2010S Bonds. The Series 2010S Bonds financed and refinanced the costs of remodeling, renovating, improving and equipping certain life care retirement communities of the Borrower, known as Claridge Court, Friendship Village of Bloomington, Friendship Village of South Hills, and Village on the Green.
