# JUDICIAL OPINION

#### ORDER

AND NOW, this 30th day of September, 2019, upon consideration of the Motion in Limine to Exclude Expert Witness Testimony, Conclusions, and Report of James E. Baranowski Proffered by Defendant, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED the Motion is GRANTED.

A claim of self-defense under 18 Pa.C.S. §505 requires that a defendant present evidence that he had a bona fide belief that he was in fear of serious bodily injury or death when he employed deadly force. See Commonwealth v. Mouzon, 53 A.3d 728, 752 (Pa. 2012). The requirement of a reasonable belief encompasses two aspects, one subjective and one objective. First, the defendant "must have acted out of an honest, bona fide belief that he was in imminent danger," which involves consideration of the defendant's subjective state of mind. Second, the defendant's belief that he needed to defend himself with deadly force, if it existed, must be reasonable in light of the facts as they appeared to the defendant, a consideration that involves an objective analysis. Id. at 752.

Psychiatric testimony has long been held admissible to prove a defendant's subjective belief that he or she is in danger of imminent death or serious bodily injury. Commonwealth v. McCloud, 455 A.2d 177, 179 (Pa.Super. 1983); accord, Commonwealth v. Light, 326 A.2d 288 (Pa. 1974)(finding that psychiatric testimony was admissible to show whether defendant acted out of an honest, bona fide belief that he was in imminent danger at time he killed victim for purposes of establishing defense of self-defense).

Even if this Court were to allow testimony concerning justifiable use of deadly force, the Commonwealth's Motion in Limine seeks to prohibit Defendant's purported expert, James E. Baranowski, from being qualified as an expert in this area.

"The decision to admit or refuse expert testimony lies within the sound discretion of the trial court," whose decision will not be reversed absent a clear abuse of that discretion. Commonwealth v. Johnson, 582 A.2d 336 (Pa.Super. 1990). Pennsylvania Rule of Evidence 702, pertaining to testimony by expert witnesses, states the following:

A witness who is qualified as an expert by knowledge, skill, experience, training, or education may testify in the form of an opinion or otherwise if:

(a) the expert's scientific, technical, or other specialized knowledge is beyond that possessed by the average layperson;

(b) the expert's scientific, technical, or other specialized knowledge will help the trier of fact to understand the evidence or to determine a fact in issue; and

(c) the expert's methodology is generally accepted in the relevant field.

#### Pa.R.E. 702.

Rule 702 directs that a witness be qualified as an expert based upon "knowledge, skill, experience, training, or education." Pa.R.E. 702. Thus, we must determine whether James E. Baranowski is qualified as an expert in the field of justifiable use of deadly force.

The Court has reviewed the curriculum vitae submitted on behalf of Mr. Baranowski and takes note of his lengthy and prestigious career with the United States Army and the Pennsylvania State Police. With regard to self-defense, Mr. Baranowski has provided, "Instruction in Self Defense Classes for women, children and men." He has also instructed on "Police Use of Force, Baton and Self Defense Tactics." Mr. Baranowski recites that he has "testified as an expert witness in the areas of crime scene processing/ photography, traffic collision reconstruction and/or police use of force."

Despite his extensive criminal investigation and police background, the Court is unable to identify any knowledge, skill, experience, training, or education that would permit him to offer opinions on Defendant's subjective belief that he was in danger of imminent death or serious bodily injury. A review of Baranowski's curriculum vitae discloses no evidence of expertise in the areas of mental health, psychology, or psychiatry as required by Pennsylvania case law. Accord, McCloud and Light, supra.

Specifically, Mr. Baranowski opined, "If we were to compare this to the use of force by a police officer, we would see that even at the much higher standards for a trained police officer, the use of force would be justified." This opinion recites a standard, being that of a police officer, that is irrelevant to the instant action of this Defendant, who is not a police officer.

As such, Defendant is not permitted to present the testimony of Mr. Baranowski as an expert witness because he lacks any specialized knowledge, training, education or experience on Defendant's subjective belief that he was in danger of imminent death or serious bodily injury such that his actions constituted justifiable use of deadly force.
