

# JUDICIAL OPINION

#### IN THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF FAYETTE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA CRIMINAL DIVISION

Before this Court is an Omnibus Pretrial Motion Nunc Pro Tune (Motion to Suppress Statement) filed by the Defendant, Joshua Grimm (hereinafter "Grimm.") Grimm asserts that some of his incriminating statements made at the scene of the stop must be suppressed because he was not advised of his Miranda rights by the PA State Police. This Court disagrees.

#### BACKGROUND

The sole evidence presented was the mobile video recording of the vehicle stop. Defendant was stopped for allegedly leaving his high beams on while operating behind a State Police vehicle, but that aspect precedes the recording. Grimm was pulled over on a side street in the east end of Uniontown. Two Troopers approached. They saw a pistol on the front seat, and could see that the Defendant was wearing a holster on his belt in plain view even before he was asked to step out of the car. He was removed from the vehicle and patted down, and was then asked to sit on the front push bar of the police vehicle, where he was subjected to some additional investigatory questions.

#### DISCUSSION

Pennsylvania courts have recognized that under limited circumstances police officers are justified in investigating a situation and may conduct a brief, investigatory detention of an individual, so long as the police officers reasonably believe that criminal activity may be afoot. In re C.C.J., 799 A.2d 116 (Pa. Super. 2002). In ascertaining evidence of reasonable suspicion, one must look to the totality of the circumstances. Commonwealth v. Riley, 415 A.2d 1131, 1135 (Pa. Super. 1998). An officer must be able to present specific, articulable facts and reasonable inferences drawn from those facts in light of the officer's experience in order to establish reasonable suspicion. Commonwealth v. Jackson, 698 A.2d 571 (1997).

Grimm argues the officers violated his constitutionally protected rights by failing to read him his Miranda warnings after removing him from his vehicle. Miranda warnings

are triggered by custodial interrogation. Commonwealth v. McAliely, 919 A.2d 272 (Pa. Super. 2007). A person is in custody when a reasonable person in the defendant's position would believe that he or she is being deprived of or restricted in his or her freedom of action due to pressures of official authority. Commonwealth v. Umstead, 916 A.2d 1146 (Pa. Super. 2007).

For car stops, in particular, the United States Supreme Court has clarified that during the course of a car stop or traffic stop the police need only give Miranda warnings while detaining a suspect by the side of the public highway when the suspect is actually placed under arrest or when the questioning of the suspect is so prolonged or coercive as to approximate the atmosphere of a station house interrogation. Commonwealth v. Gonzalez, 546 A.2d 26 (1988).

In this case, since the officers only detained Grimm temporarily by a show of authority for investigatory purposes, this Court finds that the interaction did not amount to the functional equivalent of an arrest such as to constitute a custodial detention. Accordingly, the officers only had to harbor a reasonable suspicion that Grimm was engaged in unlawful activity for an investigatory detention to be lawful. After review of the record the Court finds the Commonwealth has demonstrated much more than just reasonable suspicion.

The Court finds, by a preponderance of the evidence, that Grimm committed a Vehicle Code violation, and was thereafter stopped. Upon approaching the vehicle, the gun and the holster were in plain view. It was perfectly legal and appropriate to inquire whether the gun was the defendant's and whether he had a permit to carry it. Further, the investigatory detention conducted by the officers was fairly brief and the officers questioning did not "approximate the atmosphere of a police barracks interrogation." In any event, the facts disclosed-that the defendant did not have a license to carry a firearm and was a "person not to possess" were inevitably going to be discovered anyway. The Defendant denied possessing any unlawful drugs, but they were found anyway. As a result, the Court finds Miranda warnings at that time were unnecessary.

Wherefore, the Court enters the following ORDER:

#### ORDER

AND NOW, this 12th day of December, 2022, after full consideration of the record in this matter it is hereby ORDERED and DIRECTED that Defendant's Omnibus Pretrial Motion is DENIED.

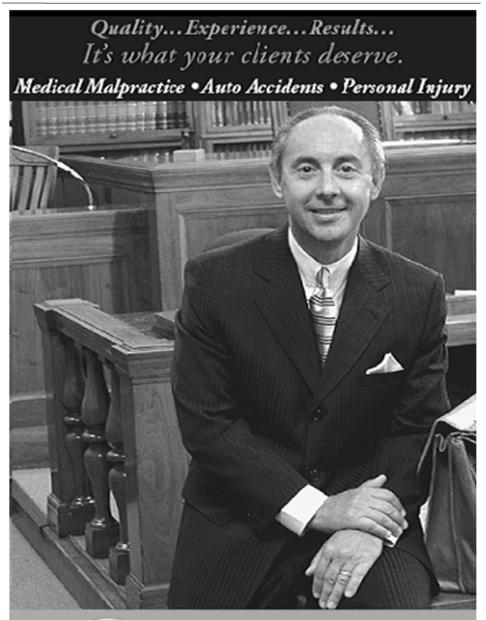
