Commonwealth v. McCuaig

Probable cause for warrantless arrest - Consent to search vehicle

- Probable cause to arrest exists when the facts and circumstances within the police
 officer's knowledge and of which the officer has reasonably trustworthy information
 are sufficient in themselves to warrant a person of reasonable caution in the belief
 that an offense has been committed by the person to be arrested.
- 2. Probable cause justifying a warrantless arrest is determined by the totality of the circumstances.
- 3. The odor of marijuana alone does not always establish probable cause. Rather, it is a factor that may contribute to a finding of probable cause when assessed under the totality of the circumstances test.
- 4. Because a defendant states they do not or did not smoke marijuana does not mean he cannot legally possess marijuana.
- 5. Eye tremors are not an ordinary sign of ingestion of a controlled substance, in particular, marijuana.
- A trooper initiated a traffic stop for Defendant's vehicle having travelled 89 miles per hour in a 55 miles per hour zone on Route 202. Defendant promptly pulled to the shoulder. The trooper was unable to state with particularity whether he detected the odor of fresh or burnt marijuana, which is relevant to probable cause. The trooper did not collect the "marijuana shake" he observed to have it chemically tested, nor did he inquire as to the defendant's ability to legally possess marijuana. Most importantly, the Defendant did not admit to prior marijuana usage until after being placed under arrest. The trooper had Defendant perform tests on the shoulder of a multi-lane, high speed highway and testified Defendant generally performed adequately on the tests. Further, it is unreasonable to expect anyone pulled to the side of a multi-lane highway in the middle of the morning with traffic passing at high rates of speed to remain perfectly still. Under the totality of the circumstances, even in the light most favorable to the Commonwealth, the trooper did not possess sufficient probable cause to conduct a warrantless arrest of Defendant. Furthermore, the trooper did not have lawful consent to search Defendant's vehicle. Accordingly, the Court *Held* Defendant's Motion to Suppress Physical Evidence and Statements Based on Lack of Probable Cause to Arrest was granted and his Motion to Suppress Physical Evidence Based on Illegal Search of his Vehicle was also granted.

DECISION AND ORDER

On January 25, 2023, Defendant, Timothy McCuaig, filed an Omnibus Pre-Trial Motion to Suppress Evidence. Mr. McCuaig, by and through his attorney, Michael Skinner, Esquire, asserted his arrest as conducted by Pennsylvania State Police Trooper Craig Fry was not supported by probable cause and any evidence seized as a result of his unlawful arrest should be suppressed. On May 1, 2023, a pre-trial hearing was conducted with examination of one witness, Trooper Fry. The defendant and Commonwealth submitted supporting memorandums of law after the hearing.

I. FACTS

On May 25, 2022, at approximately 10:23 am, Trooper Fry observed a vehicle travelling at 89 miles per hour in a 55 miles per hour zone on US 202.² Trooper Fry initiated a traffic stop and defendant promptly pulled to the shoulder of the highway. The entirety of Trooper Fry's interaction with Defendant was recorded by MVR and was viewed during cross-examination of Trooper Fry.

Trooper Fry testified he approached defendant's vehicle, made contact with the Defendant, immediately detected the odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle and observed "marijuana shake" on the floor. Defendant was asked when the last time he smoked marijuana and if there was any marijuana in the vehicle. Defendant stated he did not smoke marijuana and the "marijuana shake" Trooper Fry observed was from a passenger. Trooper Fry testified he could not state whether the odor of marijuana was that of burnt or fresh marijuana. Trooper Fry further testified he did not attempt to recover the "marijuana shake" from the vehicle due to the miniscule quantity.

After providing his license, defendant had difficulty producing registration and insurance since the vehicle was a rental car and the documents were not in the vehicle. Trooper Fry stated he asked defendant to step out of the vehicle to perform standardized field sobriety tests (SFST) and he exited the vehicle without issue or further instruction. While still on the shoulder of US 202 with considerable traffic passing by at high rates of speed, defendant performed three SFST's and two Advanced

Roadside Impairment Driving Enforcement tests (ARIDE).

Trooper Fry testified and the Commonwealth argued, defendant displayed signs of impairment during four tests. First, when performing the horizontal gaze nystagmus test (HGN) Trooper Fry observed defendant's eyes to be bloodshot and instructed him to keep his head still during the test. Second, during the one leg stand (OLS) defendant swayed and put his foot down briefly. Third, defendant displayed eye tremors during the Modified Romberg Balance test (MRB). Lastly, defendant's eyes did not converge when performing the Lack of Convergence test (LOC).

Upon conclusion of the SFST's and ARIDE testing and after placing defendant under arrest in handcuffs, Trooper Fry inquired again if defendant had smoked marijuana to which defendant indicated he had the prior evening. Search incident to arrest of defendant's person revealed two loaded pistol magazines. Defendant then also admitted to being in possession of a firearm without a license. Trooper Fry testified defendant initially declined to consent to search of his vehicle and was transported to the police station for processing. Trooper Fry states once at the station, defendant provided consent to search the vehicle which yielded a loaded pistol in the center console.

II. LEGAL ANALYSIS

Defendant's pre-trial motion is two-part. First, defendant asserts Trooper Fry did not have probable cause to arrest him. Second, Trooper Fry unlawfully searched his vehicle subsequent to arrest. Accordingly, the factual findings and legal conclusions for each issue will be addressed separately.

A. Trooper Fry did not possess probable cause to arrest defendant.

"Probable cause to arrest exists when the facts and circumstances within the police officer's knowledge and of which the officer has reasonably trustworthy information are sufficient in themselves to warrant a person of reasonable caution in the belief that an offense has been committed by the person to be arrested." *Commonwealth v. Williams*, 941 A.2d 14 (Pa.Super. 2008). "Probable cause justifying a warrantless arrest is determined by the 'totality of the circumstances." *Id.*

In the instant case, the Commonwealth relies on Trooper Fry's observation and generalized smell of marijuana coupled with the indicators of impairment listed above to find probable cause for defendant's arrest. The Commonwealth is correct in stating Section 3802(d) does not require proof of actual impairment for a **conviction**, as provided in *Commonwealth v. Etchison*, 916 A.2d 1169 (Pa.Super. 2007). However, this Court is determining whether probable cause existed at the time of defendant's arrest and is not considering any information obtained post arrest.

Trooper Fry testified upon questioning the defendant initially stated he did not smoke marijuana and that any marijuana Trooper Fry saw belonged to a prior passenger. Trooper Fry specifically testified he could not state whether he detected the smell of burnt or fresh marijuana, just that he smelled it. Furthermore, at no point did

Trooper Fry state whether he detected the odor of marijuana on the defendant himself or just inside the rented vehicle. Nor did Trooper Fry inquire if defendant could legally possess marijuana. As established by caselaw, "[T]he odor of marijuana alone does not always establish probable cause. Rather, it is a factor that may contribute to a finding of probable cause when assessed under the totality-of-the-circumstances test." *Commonwealth v. Grooms*, 247 A.3d 31, 41 (Pa.Super. 2021). Simply because a defendant states they do not or did not smoke marijuana does not mean they cannot legally possess marijuana.

Trooper Fry then requested defendant to submit to three SFST's and two ARIDE tests. Despite stating he observed an unrecoverable amount of marijuana shake on the floor of the rented vehicle, Trooper Fry testified he first observed the defendant to have bloodshot eyes during the HGN test. The Trooper does not state that he observed the Defendant's eyes being bloodshot upon his initial encounter but that he observed them when performing a SFST which focused on the eyes. Trooper Fry also testified the defendant had to be instructed multiple times to keep his head still during the HGN test.

As seen on the MVR, Trooper Fry is correct that defendant was told at least once to keep his head still during the performance of the test. However, it is unreasonable to expect anyone pulled to the side of a multi-lane highway in the middle of the morning with traffic passing at high rates of speed to remain perfectly still.

Next, defendant performed the OLS and it is undisputed defendant swayed and put his foot down briefly. However, as with the HGN, it is vital to understand the surrounding circumstances of the test. As seen on the MVR, before performing the OLS, while still on the shoulder of the highway, defendant explicitly asked Trooper Fry if he would be performing the test in that spot and pointed to the slope of the ground. Trooper Fry indicated yes, and defendant began the test complying with Trooper Fry's instructions. The Court is unable to render an opinion as to the levelness of the road, however, defendant's statement can and is taken into consideration when examining the totality of the circumstances and the validity of the test and results.

Trooper Fry testified the defendant did perform fairly well on the three SFST's. He clarified, however, stating those tests were specifically for alcohol detection and he did not believe defendant was under the influence of alcohol.

The next test Trooper Fry stated defendant displayed indicators of impairment was the MRB test. During performance of the MRB, another officer arrived on scene. The second trooper approached defendant when he had his eyes closed still on the side of the highway and stood within arm's length of him. It is entirely reasonable for defendant to have become distracted, or even concerned, in the performance of the test upon sensing the approach of another person while defendant's eyes were closed on the side of a high speed, multi-lane highway.

Trooper Fry further testified, over defendant's objections, defendant displayed eye tremors consistent with drug use, specifically marijuana.³ This was the only indicator

of impairment Trooper Fry detected during the MRB test. Defendant estimated the passage of thirty (30) seconds within the margin of error (33 seconds) and did not sway enough to be considered as an indicator. Again, even slight sway would not be unreasonable considering the location of the testing. As provided by Superior Court,

[I]t is eminently clear that attributing body or eyelid tremors to marijuana use requires specialized knowledge with the scope of Pa.R.E. 702. Unlike staggering, stumbling, glassy or bloodshot eyes, and slurred speech, the "ordinary signs of intoxication discernable by a layperson," eye tremors are *not* an ordinary sign of ingestion of a controlled substance, in particular, marijuana.

Commonwealth v. Gause, 164 A.3d 532, 539 (Pa.Super. 2017).

Accordingly, Trooper Fry's testimony concerning eye tremors and defendant's use of marijuana will not be considered since such testimony is an inadmissible lay opinion. This testimony regarding the presence of eye tremors will be considered in assessing the totality of the circumstances.

Defendant concedes his eyes did not converge during the LOC test. However, as argued by the defendant there is a percentage of the population that is unable to converge their eyes. Furthermore, Trooper Fry testified he was aware some people cannot converge their eyes.

Under the totality of the circumstances, even in the light most favorable to the Commonwealth, Trooper Fry did not possess sufficient probable cause to arrest the defendant for driving under the influence. Trooper Fry was unable to state with particularity whether he detected the odor of fresh or burnt marijuana, which is relevant to probable cause. Trooper Fry did not collect the "shake" to have it chemically tested, nor did he inquire as to the defendant's ability to legally possess marijuana. Most importantly, defendant did not admit to prior marijuana usage until after being placed under arrest. Trooper Fry had the defendant perform three SFST's and two ARIDE tests on the shoulder of a multi-lane, high speed highway and testified he generally performed adequately on the tests.

During the SFST's defendant displayed minimal indicators of alcohol or other impairment, if at all. Considering the surrounding circumstances of the stop, the few indicators Trooper Fry testified to were not presumptively of impairment or marijuana usage. Accordingly, Trooper Fry did not possess probable cause to arrest defendant for driving under the influence. Therefore, the defendant's Motion to Suppress Physical Evidence and Statements Based on Lack of Probable Cause is GRANTED.

B. Trooper Fry unlawfully searched defendant's vehicle.

As fully discussed above, Trooper Fry did not posses probable cause to conduct a warrantless arrest of defendant. When defendant was arrested, a search incident to arrest was performed revealing two loaded pistol magazines. Trooper Fry testified, once the magazines were recovered defendant informed him of a pistol in the vehicle

and that he did not possess a license to carry. Trooper Fry asked defendant if he could search the car at that time and defendant declined. Defendant was taken to the police station and shortly thereafter his vehicle was also towed to the police station. Trooper Fry stated he informed defendant, while still in custody, a search warrant was being prepared for the vehicle. Trooper Fry testified defendant consented to search of the vehicle once informed of the potential warrant and the amount of time it would take to secure. The search revealed a loaded pistol.

Based on the analysis in the above section, all evidence recovered from defendant's vehicle shall be suppressed. The voluntariness of defendant's statement does not change the analysis. Therefore, defendant's Motion to Suppress Physical Evidence Based on Illegal Search of Defendant's Vehicle is GRANTED.

III. CONCLUSION

Accordingly, defendant's two Motions to Suppress are GRANTED. Trooper Fry did not have probable cause to conduct a warrantless arrest of defendant. Trooper Fry did not have lawful consent to search defendant's vehicle.
