#### SUMMARY OF OPINION:

Defendants in this malpractice action filed preliminary objections seeking to strike plaintiff's agency allegations for failure to identify the defendants' action or ostensible agents by name, to set forth those agents' authority, and to aver how the agents' tortious conduct either fell within the scope of that authority or was ratified by the defendant- principals. Although the Superior Court originally required that degree of specificity in pleadings, its more recent precedent states that a principal may be vicariously liable for the negligence of an employee even if that alleged employee is "unnamed within a complaint." Based upon that current authority, the failure to identify a healthcare provider's agent by name, or the designation of agents as a unit, i.e., the staff, does not justify striking agency allegations in a complaint. Therefore, defendants' preliminary objections were overruled.

#### SUMMARY OF OPINION:

The plaintiff in this auto case asserted claims for negligence, negligent entrustment, breach of contract, and statutory bad faith against the other driver, the family member who entrusted his vehicle to that motorist, plaintiff's own insurer, and an insurance agent, and following the close of the pleadings, the agent filed a motion for judgment on the pleadings. Even if the factual allegations of the complaint were accepted as true, plaintiff failed to state cognizable claims against the insurance agent for negligence, negligent entrustment, breach of contract, or bad faith liability under 42 Pa.C.S. § 8371. Furthermore, the bad faith statute only governs the conduct of an "insurer" and does not apply to an insurance agent. Based upon the plaintiff's admissions in her pleadings, the agent was entitled to judgment in his favor as a matter of law, and as a result, his motion for judgment on the pleadings was granted.
