SUMMARY OF OPINION:

In this malpractice action alleging negligence and recklessness in the prenatal, labor, delivery, and neonatal care of a child, the defendant – hospital filed motions for partial summary judgment as to plaintiff's ostensible agency claim and demand for punitive damages. Under 40 P.S. § 1303.516, the plaintiff may establish the vicarious liability of a hospital for the actions of its ostensible agents by proving either (1) that a reasonably prudent patient would have been justified in the belief that the care was being rendered by an agent of the hospital, or (2) that the care furnished by the alleged agent was advertised or represented to the plaintiff as treatment delivered by a hospital agent. In light of the signage on the exterior and interior of the physicians' medical offices, when coupled with the connection of those offices to the hospital's main entrance by an elevated walkway, issues of fact existed as to whether a reasonably prudent person would conclude that the care was being rendered by a hospital agent, or that the hospital represented to the public that care furnished by those physicians was rendered by a hospital agent, or that the hospital represented to the public that care furnished by those physicians was rendered by an agent of the hospital. Under 40 P.S. § 1303.505, a principal may be vicariously liable for punitive damages based upon the wanton or reckless conduct of an agent only if the principal "knew of and allowed the conduct by its agent that resulted in the award of punitive damages." Since the summary judgment record lacked any evidence that the hospital knew of some reckless indifference by the health care providers, but nonetheless allowed it to occur, it do not contain evidence supporting a finding of vicarious liability for punitive damages.

SUMMARY OF OPINION:

A tenant of the county housing authority filed a negligence action seeking damages for health complications caused by sewage, mold, and hazardous fumes that developed from defects in the sewage, ventilation, and plumbing systems of the residential property that the housing authority leased to her. The housing authority filed preliminary objections seeking to dismiss the tort action based upon the gist of the action doctrine, which precludes a plaintiff from recasting a breach of contract claim as a tort claim, and pursuant to the Sovereign Immunity Act that insulates a housing authority form tort liability unless the harm was caused by a dangerous condition that derived or originated from the housing authority's real property. The housing authority also demurred to the tenant's demand for "the costs of this action" in her prayer for relief, and argued that the tenant could not recover "counsel fees" absent express statutory authorization, a clear agreement of the parties, or some other established exception.

Although the parties' lease created their landlord-tenant relationship, the duties allegedly breached by the housing authority arose from broader societal duties imposed by Pennsylvania tort law rather than the parties' contract, and as such, the tort claim was not barred by the gist of the action doctrine. Additionally, once the sewage, ventilation, and plumbing systems were installed in the authority's rental unit and became affixed to it, they became part of the authority's real estate itself, as a result of which the dangerous conditions at issue arguably developed and stemmed from the authority's real estate is as to fall within the real estate exception to tort immunity set forth in the Sovereign Immunity Act. Furthermore, since the tenant merely demanded taxable costs, as opposed to an award of counsel fees, her prayer for relief was legally sufficient. Accordingly, the housing authority's preliminary objections in the nature of demurrers were overruled.
