## Commonwealth v. Hardenfelder

Dog law violations - Propensity to attack - Mens rea

- 1. The defendant was charged with failure to confine a dog within owner's premises, etc.; harboring a dangerous dog; and failure to confine a dog until disposition of court proceedings.
- 2. Although a propensity to attack may be proven by a single incident, the Court found there was no propensity to attack and found the defendant not guilty of harboring a dangerous dog.
- 3. Because the dog was seen running around its yard unrestrained after a report was filed, the Court found the defendant guilty of failure to confine a dog until disposition of court proceedings.
- 4. The defendant's dog attacked a neighbor's dog on the neighbor's property. The Court <u>Held</u> that no *mens rea* or scienter is required for failure to confine a dog within the owner's premises and, accordingly, found the defendant guilty of that charge.

## **ORDER**

**AND NOW**, this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October, 2012, the Defendant, Donna Hardenfelder, is hereby found:

- 1. **GUILTY** of violating 3 P.S. §459-305(a)(1), a summary offense, regarding confinement of dogs.
- 2. **NOT GUILTY** of Harboring a Dangerous Dog under 3 P.S. §459-502-A(a), a summary offense.
- 3. **GUILTY** of Disposition of Dog During Court Proceedings, 3 P.S. §459-502-A(d), a summary offense.<sup>1</sup>

The Criminal Court Administrator is directed to list this matter for sentencing.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup>This is a criminal prosecution of Donna Hardenfelder for three violations of the Dog Law which arose from a dog fight that occurred on March 16, 2012. From the evidence presented at the trial on July 31, 2012, the court finds the following facts. At about 2:30 that afternoon, Marijaye Tyson-Hampton, who resides in Cochranville, PA, let her three small dogs out in her yard. By name they are Sweetie, Tessa and Gigi. Defendant Hardenfelder is the next door neighbor. Her dog, Allie, was with the defendant's son, Will Hardenfelder, in a shed where Will was working on a lawn mower. Allie left the shed and ran over to where Ms. Tyson-Hampton was standing with her three dogs, a distance of about 90 yards. Ms. Tyson-Hampton became alarmed and called for Will. Allie was wearing an "e-collar", which

could produce either an electric shock, or a beeping noise, from a remote control which Will had.

Will walked over to where Ms. Tyson-Hampton and the dogs were. He testified he felt he did not have to "beep" Allie. He told Ms. Tyson-Hampton he knew that Allie would not be a problem. When he arrived the four dogs were sniffing each other. He and Ms. Tyson-Hampton engaged in some small talk for about ten minutes. During this period of time, Tessa, a cocker-shitsu mix, instigated play with Allie by running around the Tyson-Hampton house. At some point, another neighbor's Rottweiler barked from behind a fence. Allie went over to investigate, but was "beeped" back by Will. A stranger then drove in down the driveway towards the group to ask directions. Mrs. Tyson-Hampton's daughter joined the group. Allie did not react aggressively to any of these developments.

However, while the Tyson-Hampton dogs were sitting or lying still, Allie straddled Gigi and attacked the smaller dog. Gigi did not bite, snap at or growl; there was no provocation of any kind. Allie grabbed Gigi and began to shake her violently. After 30 seconds to a minute, Will was able to separate the dogs and took Allie home.

Gigi required emergency veterinary care due to serious injuries, including deep puncture wounds and broken bones in her paw. The treating veterinarian, Dr. Platt, was called to testify and presented photos of the injured dog; the situation was touch-and-go but Gigi did recover.

The Hardenfelders were relatively new to the neighborhood, having moved in the prior November. Gigi was new to the Tyson-Hampton household, having lived there only two or three days. Although Allie had previously been on the Tyson-Hampton property, perhaps on ten earlier occasions, all without incident, this was the first occasion in which Allie and Gigi were together.

Allie had no prior history of attacking or biting other people, other dogs, or any other animals. There was unrebutted evidence that Allie had been around many dogs previously without incident, that Allie had successively completed an obedience school and that she had never displayed any sort of aggression. A boxer-pitbull mix, Allie's weight at 65 pounds was approximately four times heavier than Gigi, a Maltese-poodle mix.

## [60 Ches. Co. Rep. Commonwealth v. Hardenfelder

The defense called Carol A. Siegrist, a certified professional dog trainer and canine consultant. Ms. Siegrist has been a behavioral specialist with problem dogs for approximately ten years and lectures veterinary students at the SPCA where she has been requested to conduct a program. She has investigated 150 cases involving allegedly dangerous dogs and has examined in 350 cases altogether. She was qualified as an expert witness in the area of dog handling and behavior.

She evaluated Allie in the Hardenfelder home and manipulated the dog in various ways to assess the dog's responses, such as by touching the dog, pushing down on her, squeezing her paws and so forth. She was looking for the degree of interaction and testified that her methods were generally accepted within the professional community. There was no display of aggression. She stated that dogs warn by growling. There was no such display and Allie exhibited no aggressive behaviors. The court has decided to credit the next opinion she gave which was, if the dog had been aggressive, there would have been an immediate attack at the Tyson-Hampton residence. As it was, ten minutes had elapsed before the incident without the dog becoming aroused, even though a stranger had come and gone, another person joined the group, and there was an interlude with a barking Rottweiler. Ms. Siegrist offered her opinion that Allie was not a dangerous dog.

Ms. Siegrist stated "It was just a dog fight. It happens." She also denied the proposition that boxers or pitbulls or boxer-pitbull mixes were aggressive by breed.

Mrs. Hardenfelder was charged with failure to confine a dog within the owner's premises, harboring a dangerous dog, and failure to confine a dog until disposition of court proceedings. The elements of each offense are as follows:

## 3 Pa. C.S.A.§459-305. Confinement and housing of dogs not part of a kennel

- (a) **Confinement and control**. It shall be unlawful for the owner or keeper of any dog to fail to keep it at all times the dog in any of the following manners:
- (1) confined within the premises of the owner;

- (2) firmly secured by means of a collar and chain or other device so that it cannot stray beyond the premises on which it is secured.
- (3) under the reasonable control of some person, or when engaged in lawful hunting, exhibition, performance events or field training.

## §459-502-A. Court proceedings, certificate of registration and disposition

- (a) Summary offense of harboring a dangerous dog. Any person who has been attacked by one or more dogs, or anyone on behalf of the person, a person whose domestic animal, dog or cat has been killed or injured without provocation, the State dog warden or the local police officer may file a complaint before a magisterial district judge charging the owner of the summary offense of harboring a dangerous dog if the magisterial district judge finds beyond a reasonable doubt that the following elements of the offense has been proven:
- (1) The dog has done any of the following:
  - (i) inflicted severe injury on a human being without provocation on public or private property.
  - (ii) killed or inflicted severe injury on a domestic animal, dog or cat without provocation while off the owner's property.
  - (iii) attacked a human being

without provocation.

- (iv) been used in the commission of a crime.
- (2) The dog has either or both of the following:
  - (i) a history of attacking human beings and/or domestic animals, dogs or cats without provocation.
  - (ii) A propensity to attack human beings and/or domestic animals, dogs or cats without provocation. A propensity to attach may be proven by a single incident of the conduct described in paragraph (1)(i), (ii), (iii) or (iv).
- (3) The defendant is the owner or keeper of the dog.

## (d) Disposition of dog during court proceedings.

An owner or keeper of any dog who has been charged with harboring a dangerous dog shall keep the dog or dogs confined in a proper enclosure or, when off the property of the owner or keeper for purposes of veterinary care, muzzled and on a leash until the time a report is made under subsection (b). if an appeal of a decision under subsection (b) is filed, the dog or dos shall remain so confined until the proceedings are completed. It shall be unlawful for an owner or keeper of a dog who has been charged with harboring a dangerous dog to dispense, move, sell, offer to sell, give away or transfer the dog in any manner except to have it humanely killed or move the dog to a licensed kennel if approved by the investigating officer. A violation of

this subsection shall constitute a summary offense accompanied by a fine of not less than \$500.00

A determination of guilt in this case is largely dependent upon whether a *mens rea* is required to be proven, or if instead the Dog Law provisions are governed by strict liability.

The court has, after reflection,	determined that this case is	controlled by Con	nmonwealth v.
Raban, 31 A.3d 699 (Pa. Super.	2011); alloc. granted,	Pa,	A.3d
(2012), holding tha	nt no mens rea or scienter is	required for conv	iction.

In *Raban*, the keeper of the dog, Simon Raban, was charged by the Commonwealth for not keeping his dog within the confines of his property. He did not leash it, put an electric collar on it, nor keep the dog within his view. The dog charged across the street to attack another dog that was being walked by its owner. The owner of the dog, Mr. Alvin, witnessed the attack along with a neighbor on the street, Mr. Sawicki. Mr. Raban came out afterward due to the commotion and brought his dog back onto his premises. The trial court held that Mr. Raban was guilty of not properly confining his dog within the premises of the owner and further went on to state that 3 Pa. C.S.A. §459-305 was not a negligence but a strict liability offense and thus no scienter was required to be guilty of it. The Superior Court of Pennsylvania has affirmed.

Referring to the confinement of dogs under 3 P.S. §459-305(1), the statute states that it shall be unlawful to fail to keep at all times one's dog within the confines of one's premises. This provision is stated absolutely and not in terms of reasonable care. Had the legislature intended to condition culpability on the failure to make reasonable efforts of confinement, it could have so stated in §305(a)(1).

Applying this standard, the court must find the defendant guilty of failing to keep her dog at all times confined upon her premises, or firmly secured by means of a collar and chain so that it cannot stray beyond that premises.

This court finds no guilt on the charge under 3 P.S. §459-502-A(a), harboring a dangerous dog, as the elements are not all met for such a finding. The statute here is to be read in the conjunctive, requiring that element (a)(1), element (a)(2) and element (a)(3) all be met, *Commonwealth v. Baldwin*, 767 A.2d 644 at 646 (Pa. Commw. Ct. 2001). The court finds that neither sub-part of element 2 were established, to wit: "(i) a history of attacking human

beings and/or domestic animals, dogs or cats without provocation. (ii) A propensity to attack *may* be proven by a single incident of the conduct described..." 459-502-A(a)(2)(ii) (emphasis added). While an argument has been advanced by the Commonwealth that the dog in question has a propensity to attack based on this single incident, the court finds instead that, due to the isolated nature of the incident, a lack of history of violent behavior, and the fact that the attack occurred 10 minutes after initial contact, such propensity has not been made out by the evidence. Because the statute states a "propensity to attack *may* be proven by a single incident," the court is allowed to decide whether an individual incident is indicative of a propensity to attack, or not. Here, we find that it is not.

On the third and final charge, disposition of the dog during court proceedings under 3 P.S. §459-502-A(d) we find the defendant guilty. Evidence was adduced at trial by eye-witness testimony that Allie, defendant's dog, was observed unrestrained and running around the yard after the incident and after a report was filed. The statute provides in relevant part that:

"An owner or keeper of any dog who has been charged with harboring a dangerous dog shall keep the dog or dogs confined in a proper enclosure or, when off the property of the owner or keeper for purposes of veterinary care, muzzled and on a leash until the time a report is made..."

We note that allocatur has been granted by the Supreme Court in Commonwealth v. Raban.




