SUMMARY OF OPINION:

A former police officer's disability pension was revoked by the police pension board pursuant to the Public Employee Pension Forfeiture Act ("PEPFA"), Act of July 8, 1978, P.L. 752, No. 140, *as amended*, 43 P.S. §§ 1311-1315, and a municipal ordinance governing police pensions based upon his federal felony conviction for knowingly stealing federal funds by receiving compensation totaling \$17,831.40 for extra-duty patrol shifts that he never worked at lower-income housing complexes. A pension is subject to forfeiture under PEPFA if the public official or employee is convicted of a federal offense that is "substantially the same" as one of the state crimes identified in that statute, or under the ordinance if the employee is "convicted of a felony." The ex-officer appealed the forfeiture of his pension on the grounds that: (1) his federal conviction was not "essentially identical" to a state crime enumerated in PEPFA; (2) the pension ordinance was unconstitutionally "void for vagueness" and in conflict with PEPFA; and (3) the pension board violated his procedural due process rights in the manner in which it revoked his pension.

The elements of the former officer's federal offense were essentially identical to the state crime of theft by deception under 18 Pa.C.S. § 3922(a)(1), which is a state crime enumerated in PEPFA as warranting the forfeiture of pension benefits. That federal felony conviction was also "substantially the same" as a state crime "classified as a felony or punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding five years," which provided an independent basis for revocation of a public pension under PEPFA. Since a court should not address constitutional issues if a case can be decided on non-constitutional grounds, and the revocation of the subject pension was proper under PEPFA, it was unnecessary to consider the ex-officer's constitutional arguments relating to the pension ordinance.

Procedural due process entitles an individual to adequate notice of proceedings, the opportunity to be heard, and the chance to litigate issues before a fair and impartial tribunal. The certified record reflected that the former officer was provided sufficient written notice of all hearings, afforded ample opportunity to argue and present his case at five hearings, and granted special accommodations in order to testify and participate remotely from federal prison. Contrary to the officer's contentions, the pension board's solicitor did not act in an adjudicative capacity, the officer's request to introduce testimony from the pension board members regarding the standards and reasoning that they applied in reaching their decisions was protected from disclosure by the deliberative process privilege, and the pension board issued a written decision containing adequate factual findings and legal conclusions. Accordingly, the officer's procedural due process arguments were without merit, and the pension board's decision to revoke his public pension was affirmed.
