Motion to Expunge and Vacate Involuntary Commitment

- 18 Pa.C.S. § 6105(f)(1) authorizes a court to lift the firearm prohibition imposed by § 6105(c)(4) but it does not provide a basis to challenge the commitment itself and it is silent as to the expunction of the prior commitment.
- 2. Expungement cannot be obtained upon a free-standing constitutional challenge, based on alleged due process violations, because claims of a constitutional dimension do not confer jurisdiction on a court to adjudicate them and they must be brought in a manner specified by law, and in a timely fashion, or else they are waived.
- 3. A constitutional claim alone is insufficient to confer jurisdiction to expunge or vacate an involuntary commitment.
- 4. In 2001, an order of involuntary commitment was entered against Petitioner pursuant to the Mental Health Procedures Act. More than eighteen year after the commitment, she filed a pleading to expunge and vacate her involuntary commitment because that commitment barred Petitioner from lawfully owning a firearm. This court has concluded that it cannot grant Petitioner the relief requested because it lacks subject matter jurisdiction to reach the merits of a petition to vacate and expunge mental health treatment records. Accordingly, this Court <u>Held</u> the Motion to Expunge and Vacate Involuntary Commitment was denied.

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MEMORANDUM

On October 25, 2001, the Honorable Michael J. Melody, Jr. entered an Order of Commitment against Petitioner "pursuant to the provisions of Section 304 of the Mental Health Procedures Act, Act of July 9, 1976, P.L. 817, No. 143, 50 P.S. 7304, for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days." Order, 10/29/2001. *See also* Petition, 6/10/2020 (Exhibit "A"). That involuntary commitment is a bar to Petitioner's owning or possessing a firearm under Pennsylvania law, 18 Pa.C.S. § 6105(c)(4), and federal law, 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(4). Petition, 6/10/2020, ¶¶ 13, 18.

Petitioner filed her Petition on June 10, 2020.¹ Petitioner's ultimate goal is to have a firearm and to that end Petitioner expressly asked this court to expunge her involuntary commitment. Petition, 6/10/2020, ¶ 17, 19, 22. *See also* (Proposed Order attached to Petition). Petitioner rested her request for expungement on two (2) grounds. The first was 18 Pa.C.S. § 6105(f)(1). Petition, 6/10/2020, ¶¶ 14-17. The second was "the Second Amendment of the United States Constitution and Article 1, Section 21 of the Pennsylvania State Constitution, since to deny M.B.'s expungement of her 302 [sic] Commitment, thereby denies her the ability to purchase and possess a firearm in her private life." Petition, 6/10/2020, ¶ 22.

Petitioner implicitly asked this court to vacate her involuntary commitment. See Petition, 6/10/2020, ¶ 20 (alleging that 18 Pa.C.S. § 6111.1(g)(1) obliges the Pennsylvania State Police to expunge involuntary treatment records when a court vacates a final order). See also Petition, 6/10/2020 (title). It was this court's surmise that Petitioner rested her implicit request on 18 Pa.C.S. §6105(f)(1). See Petition, 6/10/2020, ¶ 16 ("Section 6105(f)(1) is unique, in that it is the only section in 6105 that gives the court the ability to 'grant such relief as it deems appropriate."").

This court has concluded that it cannot grant Petitioner the relief requested. In In re J.M.Y., 218 A.3d 404 (Pa. 2019) the Pennsylvania Supreme Court held that the trial court lacked subject matter jurisdiction to reach the merits of a petition to vacate and expunge mental health treatment records. The petitioner had been involuntarily committed pursuant to Section 303 of the Mental Health Procedures Act ("MHPA"), 50 P.S. § 7303 (Extended involuntary emergency treatment certified by a judge or mental health review officer--Not to exceed twenty days). The petition was filed two (2) years after the involuntary commitment and it sought relief under the Pennsylvania Uniform Firearms Act, 18 Pa.C.S. §§ 6111.1(g)(2) and 6105(f)(1). The Pennsylvania Supreme Court held that neither of those provisions authorize a court to review a commitment under Section 303.

Regarding § 6111.1(g)(2), the Pennsylvania Supreme Court noted that the subsection's authorization to file a petition was limited by its terms to "[a] person who

Chambers made inquiry of counsel on February 24, 2021 to learn by return phone call that the Petition had been forwarded upon counsel's request and that the Petition remained active and that a rule returnable and a hearing date were desired. Petitioner's Certificate of Service, filed June 10, 2020 reflects that the Petition was served on the Chester County Department of Mental Health and the Pennsylvania State Police. No Response was

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is involuntarily committed pursuant to section 302 of the Mental Health Procedures Act..." 218 A.3d at 416 (quoting 18 Pa.C.S. § 6105(f)(1) (emphasis in opinion omitted). The Pennsylvania Supreme Court would not "rewrite th[at] section to authorize review of Section 303 involuntary commitments when the legislature has chosen not to include such a review process." 218 A.3d at 416.

Regarding \S 6105(f)(1), the Pennsylvania Supreme Court noted that the subsection authorizes a court to lift the firearm prohibition imposed by \S 6105(c)(4) but it "does not provide a basis to challenge the commitment itself [and it] is silent as to the expunction of the prior commitment." 218 A.3d at 416-17.

Finally, the Pennsylvania Supreme Court addressed the argument that expungement could be obtained upon "a free-standing constitutional challenge, based on alleged due process violations." 218 A.3d at 415, fn. 14. The Pennsylvania Supreme Court rejected that argument because "claims of a constitutional dimension d[o] not confer jurisdiction on a court to adjudicate them. Even constitutional challenges must be brought in a manner specified by law, and in a timely fashion, or else they are waived." 218 A.3d at 417 (citing Commonwealth v. Knox, 190 A.3d 1146, 1152 (Pa. 2018)).

Here, Defendant's [sic] Motion to Expunge and Vacate Involuntary Commitment, filed more than eighteen (18) years after her commitment, is foursquare in accord with In re J.M.Y. Neither 18 Pa.C.S. §§ 6111.1(g)(2) nor 6105(f)(1) authorize a court to expunge an involuntary commitment entered pursuant to Section 304 of the Mental Health Procedures Act. Petitioner invoked the Second Amendment of the United States Constitution and Article 1, Section 21 of the Pennsylvania State Constitution but In re J.M.Y. makes clear that a constitutional claim alone is insufficient to confer jurisdiction to expunge or vacate an involuntary commitment.

Accordingly, for the reasons set forth above, this court will enter an order denying Defendant's [sic] Motion to Expunge and Vacate Involuntary Commitment, filed June 10, 2020.
