SUBJECT: Inmate Transportation Orders and Continuances

In order to maintain a uniform policy and clarification regarding Transportation orders, the following information is being provided:

- 1. Transportation orders are NOT needed if a defendant is an NCP inmate housed at SCI-Coal Township.
- 2. Transportation orders ARE needed if a defendant is an NCP inmates housed at a State Correctional Institute OTHER than SCI-Coal Township. If an NCP inmate is being housed at a State Correctional Institution OTHER THAN SCI-Coal Township, a transportation order must be completed and filed no later than 14 working days in advance of the scheduled hearing.
- 3. A transportation Order MUST be completed and filed for all State Correctional Inmates no later than 14 working days in advance of the scheduled hearing.
- 4. If a Continuance is requested and granted regarding an inmate where a Transportation Order has been filed, the Sheriff's Office shall be made aware of the continuance to prevent unnecessary costs and expenditure of manpower. (There have been incidents where inmates were transported from a SCI location and the Sheriff's Office was not notified of the Continuance).
- 5. It shall be the responsibility of the person (or designee) who requests the Continuance to notify the Sheriff's Office of said continuance prior to the scheduled court date should the Continuance be granted.
- 6. In the instance where the defendant/inmate is Pro Se, it shall be the responsibility of the Northumberland County District Attorney's Office.

BAR NEWS

PFA

The Superior Court recently affirmed a Northumberland County Court Of Common Pleas conviction for indirect criminal contempt (ICC) resulting from a violation of a Protection from Abuse final order.

In <u>Com v. Elliott</u>, (1255 MDA 2016) Pa. Super March 15, 2017, the pertinent facts are as follows:

(1) A final PFA order was entered after a hearing in which the Appellant did not appear; (2) the PFA order prohibited Appellant from contact with the victim; (3) 2 weeks after the final PFA order was entered and still in effect, the Appellant approached the victim's car, reached through the car window, grabbed the victim and struck her in the head; and (4) the victim then filed a police report which resulted in the ICC charge.

At the ICC hearing the Court sentenced Appellant to 3-6 months incarceration and extended the PFA for 6 more months.

The Superior Court affirmed the trial Court Order noting that the record reflected the Appellant receiving notice and the trial Court in observing the bruises on the victim noted, "these are some of the most serious injuries I have ever seen in some time in a PFA case", and the victim was hospitalized as a result thereof.
