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Winters vs. Patient First, Wilson and Vinshtok

Motion for reconsideration – Preliminary objections - Motion for extension of time – Certificate of merit

- 1. Motions for reconsideration are directed to the discretion of the court and may be granted when there is a clear error made by the court that causes manifest injustice.
- 2. Mere disagreement with the court's conclusion is not a basis for reconsideration.
- 3. If preliminary objections are overruled, the objecting party shall have the right to plead over within twenty days after notice of the order or within such other time as the court shall fix.
- 4. If a court grants a motion to strike a claim for noncompliance with the requirements of Rule 1042.3(b), the court shall grant the plaintiff twenty days to file a certificate of merit which cures the defect.
- 5. A defendant against whom a professional liability claim is asserted shall file a responsive pleading within the time required by Rule 1026 or within twenty days after service of the certificate of merit on that defendant, whichever is later.
- 6. A court, upon good cause shown, shall extend the time for filing a certificate of merit for a period not to exceed sixty days.
- 7. Good cause is not shown unless the motion for an extension sets forth specific information upon which the court can find that the movant has acted with due diligence.
- 8. Pa.R.Civ.P. 1042(a)(1) requires a written statement opine that there exists a reasonable probability that the care, skill or knowledge exercised or exhibited in the treatment, practice or work that is the subject of the complaint, fell outside acceptable professional standards and that such conduct was a cause in bringing about the harm.
- 9. Plaintiff filed a Complaint alleging that a doctor negligently prescribed medication for Plaintiff's minor daughter, which caused harm to Plaintiff. The court entered order that denied Defendants' motion seeking dismissal based on Plaintiff's lack of standing, ruling that the motion was no substitute for a properly raised demurrer; and granted Defendants' motion to strike certificates of merit from a pharmacist. Defendants filed a motion for reconsideration as to the motion regarding standing. This court cannot conclude from Plaintiff's motion for an extension of time that Plaintiff has acted with due diligence or shown good cause. Further, Plaintiff's motion is based on speculation. Accordingly, this Court Held Defendants' request for this court to grant Defendants' previously filed motion to dismiss based on a lack of standing was denied; Defendants' request to be allotted twenty days from the filing of proper certificates of merit to file a responsive pleading was granted; and Plaintiff's motion for extension of time to respond to the court's prior order was denied.

AND NOW, this 17th day of December, 2024, upon consideration of (1) Defendants' Motion for Reconsideration and Clarification and (2) Plaintiff's Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to 11/21/2024 Order, both filed on December 11, 2024, for the reasons set forth in the accompanying Memorandum it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1 Defendants' request for this court to grant Defendants' previously filed Motion to Dismiss Based on Plaintiff's Lack of Standing is **DENIED**;
- 2. Defendants' request to "be allotted twenty days from the filing of proper certificates of merit to file a responsive pleading" is **GRANTED**; and
- 3. Plaintiff's Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to 11/21/2024 Order is **DENIED**.

MEMORANDUM

On April 30, 2024, Plaintiff filed a Complaint alleging that Paul J. Wilson, D.O. negligently prescribed Paxil for Plaintiff's minor daughter causing harm to Plaintiff as follows: (1) injury to Plaintiff's relationship with his daughter; (2) loss of Plaintiff's right to legal and physical custody of his daughter; (3) medical expense; (4) pain and suffering; and (5) future loss of earnings. See Complaint, 4/30/2024, ¶¶ 21, 24, 27-28.

On November 21, 2024, this court entered an Order that decided Defendants' Preliminary Objections to Plaintiff's Complaint filed July 18, 2024. Among other things, this court: (1) denied Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Based on Plaintiff's Lack of Standing ruling that Defendants' Motion was no substitute for a properly raised demurrer while directing Defendants to file an Answer to Plaintiff's Complaint within twenty (20) days; and (2) granted Defendants' Motion to Strike Certificate[s] of Merit, ruling that Plaintiff's written statements pursuant to Pa.R.Civ.P. 1042.3(e) were insufficient as from a pharmacist while directing Plaintiff to file proper certificates of merit within twenty (20) days.

On December 11, 2024, Defendants filed a Motion for Reconsideration and Clarification. First, Defendants ask this court to grant Defendants' previously filed Motion to Dismiss Based on Plaintiff's Lack of Standing asserting that Defendants owed Plaintiff no duty and that "Plaintiff's alleged causes of actions are removed from the direct and immediate result of the alleged action and are instead remote consequences." Motion, 12/11/2024, p. 5. Defendants' belated invocation of duty and proximate cause appears to be in response to this court's previous observation that "Defendants fail to explain why Plaintiff would lack standing to bring claims on his own behalf, Brief, 7/18/2024, pp. 2-3, and Defendants' objection to Plaintiff's standing is no substitute for a properly presented demurrer." Memorandum, 11/21/2024, p. 3 (citation omitted). Even so, Defendants' belated invocation of duty and proximate cause¹ is deficient as unsupported by citation or reasoned argument. See Motion, 12/11/2024, pp. 4-5.

It has long been established that motions for reconsideration are directed to the discretion of the court and may be granted when there is a clear error made by the court that causes manifest injustice. See, e.g., Pennsylvania Railroad Co. v. Public Service Commission, 179 A. 850 (Pa. Super. 1935). Similarly, it is well-established that "Mere disagreement with the court's conclusion is not a basis for reconsideration." North Coventry Township. v. Tripodi, 2010 WL 8971894 (Chester Co. 2010). Here, Defendants have failed to show that it was error for this court not to sustain a demurrer that was never raised, and Defendants' Motion for Reconsideration amounts to mere disagreement with this court's conclusion.

However, the second part of Defendants' Motion for Reconsideration and Clarification filed December 11, 2024 has merit because it noted an inconsistency in this court's Order entered November 21, 2024. On the one hand, this court's Order denied Defendants' Motion to Dismiss Based on Plaintiff's Lack of Standing and directed

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Defendants to file a response to Plaintiff's Complaint within twenty (20) days.² On the other hand, this court granted Defendants' Motion to Strike Certificate[s] of Merit while granting Plaintiff twenty (20) days to file proper certificates of merit.³ By their Motion for Clarification, Defendants ask they "be allotted twenty days from the filing of proper certificates of merit to file a responsive pleading." Motion, 12/11/2024, p. 6. In doing so, Defendants direct this court to Pa.R.Civ.P. 1042.4 which provides that "A defendant against whom a professional liability claim is asserted shall file a responsive pleading within the time required by Rule 1026⁴ or within twenty days after service of the certificate of merit on that defendant, whichever is later." Pa.R.Civ.P. 1042.4 (footnote added). This court views Defendants' request as appropriate. See also Pa.R.J.A. 113 (Particular Controls General).

On December 11, 2024, Plaintiff filed Plaintiff's Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to 11/21/2024 Order. Plaintiff asks to have until January 11, 2025 to file proper certificates of merit on the following grounds which this court reproduces in their entirety:

- 2. The proposed extension of time is necessary because of competing deadlines on litigation and other matters. In particular, the Plaintiff is pro se and has been occupied in recent weeks working out-of-state in Vermont for the Army Corp of Engineers on a time-sensitive project. The Plaintiff was also on leave over the Thanksgiving holiday.
- 3. The Plaintiff's children's former Pediatrician is not available to meet until after Thanksgiving and Christmas regarding the certificates of merit. This same Pediatrician, a licensed Physician, will testify on behalf of Plaintiff during trial.

Motion, 12/11/2024, p. 1.

It is the law that "The court, upon good cause shown, shall extend the time for filing a certificate of merit for a period not to exceed sixty days." Pa.R.Civ.P. 1042.3(d). Good cause is not shown unless the motion for an extension sets forth specific information upon which the court can find that the movant has acted with due diligence. Glenn v. Mataloni, 949 A.2d 966, 969 (Pa.Cmwlth. 2008) ("The averments in Glenn's first and second

³ This court's directive followed Pa.R.Civ.P. 1042.8 ("If a court grants a motion to strike a claim for non-compliance with the requirements of Rule 1042.3(b), the court shall grant the plaintiff twenty days to file a certificate of merit which cures the defect."). The Rule was not strictly controlling but along with Pa.R.Civ.P. 1028(d) (see footnote, *supra*) and Pa.R.Civ.P. 1026(a) (setting forth the general twenty (20) day deadline for filing a response to a pleading) provided a reasonable guideline to set a time for Plaintiff's response given the circumstances of this case.

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requests for an extension of time do not demonstrate any actions Glenn took to try to obtain a medical statement before he filed his requests."), appeal denied, 958 A.2d 1049 (Pa. 2008). See also Pa.R.Civ.P. 1042.3(d) (note) (explaining that short notice weighs in favor of granting additional time when, for example, "despite diligent efforts by counsel, records necessary to review the validity of the claim are not available.") (emphasis added).

Here, this court cannot conclude from Plaintiff's Motion that Plaintiff has acted with due diligence. Giving Plaintiff the benefit of all reasonable inferences, Plaintiff has averred only that he has been so busy that he has had only the time to attempt unsuccessfully to arrange a meeting with his children's former pediatrician which might occur after the New Year. Plaintiff does not aver that the pediatrician has agreed to meet with Plaintiff and yet Plaintiff avers he has given priority to other litigation, work, and other unspecified matters without explaining how he has been prevented from contacting other potential experts and forwarding records for review to obtain a written statement as required by Pa.R.Civ.P. 1042.3(e) by the deadline set by this court.⁵ Plaintiff does not explain why it is necessary for Plaintiff to meet personally with his children's former pediatrician and, importantly, Plaintiff has failed to aver that the pediatrician has promised to supply written statements but hasn't yet had the time to do so.6 Instead, Plaintiff has at most averred that he has been busy and that the pediatrician hasn't the time to meet with Plaintiff so Plaintiff might ask for the required written statements. Plaintiff has placed all reliance on the hope that the pediatrician will agree to meet with Plaintiff and provide written statements so that Plaintiff can comply with this court's Order by January 11, 2025. Plaintiff's Motion is based on speculation and from Plaintiff's Motion this court cannot conclude that Plaintiff has shown good cause warranting grant of Plaintiff's request for an extension of time.

Accordingly, this court will enter an order consistent with the foregoing.

⁵ This court can credit Plaintiff's claim that he has been busy and still this court does not know what to make of Plaintiff's averment that he was on leave over the Thanksgiving holiday. That Plaintiff was freed from work obligations suggests strongly that Plaintiff became much less busy and yet Plaintiff chose to take no action hoping he could in the future schedule a meeting with the pediatrician sometime after the New Year.

⁶ Plaintiff avers that the pediatrician will testify on behalf of Plaintiff during trial, but Plaintiff does not aver that the pediatrician will testify as to negligence and causation, which is the substance of a written statement. See Pa.R.Civ.P. 1042(a)(1) (setting forth the requirement that a written statement opine that "there exists a reasonable probability that the care, skill or knowledge exercised or exhibited in the treatment, practice or work that is the subject of the complaint, fell outside acceptable professional standards and that such conduct was a cause in bringing about the harm[.]"). Without that averment, this court cannot infer that the pediatrician will agree to supply Plaintiff with the required written statements.
