#### SUMMARY OF OPINION:

Defendant who failed to appear at hearing, despite having been sent by Court written notice of hearing date and time, filed post trial motion claiming lack of notice. Referencing "mailbox rule", Court found that prepaid letter sent to Defendant at address supplied by Defendant reached its destination by due course of mail delivery, and denied motion.

HEADNOTE 1: Letter that was properly addressed, stamped, and deposited in the postal system is presumed to have been received by addressee.

HEADNOTE 2: Defendant in landlord/tenant civil action, facing potential eviction and financial liability, was responsible for attending scheduled Court proceeding and will not be subsequently heard to assert that the Court's scheduling Order, sent in the regular course of business by Court staff to Defendant at Defendant's residential address, was undelivered or "lost" in the postal system.
