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OBITER DICTUM

From *The Wall Street Journal*: [1] “Law schools hunting for students as their enrollment numbers drop are increasingly trying to attract an unexpected group: people who have no intention of practicing law. Doctors, environmental consultants and even an urban planner have signed up for the programs, which offer master’s degrees in law and typically cost about the same as one year of law school. Pitched at midcareer professionals, the programs tend to draw people who work in heavily regulated fields where compliance with a growing body of rules requires an increasingly sophisticated understanding of the law . . . online degree program in health law through Loyola University Chicago School of Law . . . Law schools are also beefing up existing programs for foreign lawyers looking for a primer in U.S. legal practice and for attorneys who want to burnish their credentials with additional degrees in intellectual property and other hot practice areas. Student enrollment in programs that don’t offer a juris doctor . . . has increased 13% since 2010, according to a Wall Street Journal analysis of American Bar Association data . . . Emory University School of Law in Atlanta and Wake Forest University School of Law . . . Fordham University School of Law . . . Law schools are grappling with steep declines in applications and enrollment amid a weak legal-jobs market. As of May 10, applications to law schools were at their lowest level, year-to-date, since 2001 . . . University of Dayton School of Law . . . Washington University School of Law.” (Article by Jennifer Smith and Ashby Jones); [2] “. . . The federal government says universities have an obligation to admit “emotional support” animals into school housing. Housing providers must offer a ‘reasonable accommodation’ for such animals, including dwellings ‘associated with a university or other place of education,’ the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development said in a notice sent last month. The notice went out after a federal judge ruled that student housing is covered by the Fair Housing Act, in a lawsuit filed by HUD against the University of Nebraska, on behalf of a student there who had requested permission to keep her 4-pound miniature pinscher in her school-owned apartment, saying he helps her cope with anxiety and depression . . .” (Article by Joe Palazzolo)

IN RE: LIMITED REPRESENTATION IN CUSTODY MATTERS

AND NOW, this 6th of August, 2013, the Washington County Court of Common Pleas recognizing the value to litigants and the Court of the representation of litigants in custody matters, decrees as follows:

(a) Any individual who is referred under the Washington County Bar Association Limited Representation Custody Program to a participating member of the Washington County Bar Association for representation as a litigant in a Custody Action, shall be granted leave to proceed in Forma Pauperis. Counsel representing these individuals shall present to the Prothonotary a Praeceptum to Proceed in Forma Pauperis which shall be endorsed by Counsel and which shall have attached to it a Certificate of Eligibility. The Praeceptum shall be in the attached format contained in Attachment 1.

(b) Any participating member of the Washington County Bar Association who provides representation to the litigant under the Washington County Bar Association Limited Representation Custody Program shall be permitted to enter a Limited Appearance. The Appearance shall be in the attached format contained in Attachment 2.

(c) Upon completion of the representation under the above described referral program, the attorney shall file a Praeceptum for Withdrawal of Limited Appearance. This Praeceptum shall be filed without leave of court. The litigant shall be given notice of the filing of the Praeceptum for Withdrawal of Limited Appearance 5 days before the filing of the Praeceptum with the Prothonotary. The Praeceptum may contain information about another attorney who may be entering his/her appearance. The Praeceptum shall direct the Prothonotary to send all future notices directly to the client and shall set forth the client's last known address unless there is a substitute attorney. The Withdrawal of Appearance shall be in the attached format contained in Attachment 3.

(d) The provisions of this order are effective immediately.
