- 3. The terms and conditions of this Court's March 19, 2020 Administrative Order, as supplemented by Administrative Order dated March 25, 2020, shall remain In full force and effect through and including Thursday, April 30, 2020; and
- 4. From the date of this Order through Thursday, April 30, 2020, this Court and the Magisterial District Judges will continue to perform essential court functions as set forth In the Court's March 19, 2020 Administrative Order.
