OPINION AND ORDER

Leskinen, J. October 25, 2021

Before the Court is the Defendant's OMNIBUS PRE-TRIAL MOTION NUNC PRO TUNC. After a careful review of the record and applicable case law, the Court hereby issues the following Opinion and Order:

#### Factual Background

A Hearing was held on this matter on October 12th, 2021. The Defendant's charges arise out of an incident which took place on January 13th, 2020 at the government- assisted housing apartments at the corner of Coolspring Street and Carlisle Street in Uniontown. Uniontown City Police Officer Jamie Holland testified that on January 13th, 2020 he observed the Defendant and two other men standing around a white folding picnic table "about ten feet in front of the residence" in a grassy area on the parking lot side of the apartments. Officer Holland testified that he observed an open bottle of "Hennessy" on the picnic table. Officer Holland and Narcotics Agent Wes Biricocchi attempted to conduct an investigative detention on the Defendant, but the Defendant ran and subsequently dropped a firearm. The Defendant was arrested and charged with Person Not to Possess/Use Firearms, 18 Pa. C.S.A. §6105(c)(1); Firearms Not to be Carried Without a License, 18 Pa. C.S.A. §6106(a)(1); Hindering Apprehension, 18 Pa. C.S.A. §5105(a)(4); and Resisting Arrest, 18 Pa. C.S.A. §5104.

#### Legal Standard

Investigative detentions must be supported by reasonable suspicion. Com. v. Hicks, 208 A.3d 916, 926 (2019). Reasonable suspicion exists only where the officer is able to articulate specific observations which, in conjunction with reasonable inferences derived from those observations, led him reasonably to conclude, in light of his experience, that criminal activity was afoot and that the person he stopped was involved in that activity. Com. v. Chambers, 55 A.3d 1208, 1215 (Pa.Super.2012).

Ordinance No. 1374, Section 2 (Codified Ordinances of the City of Uniontown, 725.03) states:

No person shall possess any glass, can or open container of alcoholic beverage on any public street, public sidewalk, public alley or public park within the City, except for persons within a motor vehicle.

#### Conclusions of Law

Colloquially referring to government-assisted housing as "public housing" does not abrogate the protections of the Fourth Amendment. In Hous. Auth. of City of Pittsburgh v. Van Osdol, the Pennsylvania Commonwealth Court ruled that residents of Section 8 housing enjoy the same expectation of privacy as residents of non-government-assisted housing, in the context of name and address records:

[A]llowing public access to the requested information would violate the housing subsidy recipients' constitutional right of privacy...

Hous. Auth. of City of Pittsburgh v. Van Osdol, 40 A.3d 209, 216 (Pa.Cmwlth. 2012).

Furthermore, the Court finds that the grassy area on the parking lot side of the government-assisted housing apartments at the corner of Coolspring Street and Carlisle Street falls neither within the public street, public sidewalk, public alley, nor public park category of Ordinance No. 1374, Section 2. The Court concludes that Officer Holland did not possess the requisite reasonable suspicion to detain the Defendant because no criminal activity was afoot.

Wherefore the Court issues the following Order:

#### ORDER

AND NOW, this 25th day of October, 2021, upon consideration of the Defendant's OMNIBUS PRE-TRIAL MOTION NUNC PRO TUNC, it is hereby ORDERED and DIRECTED that it is GRANTED. All evidence derived from the investigation of the open Hennessy bottle is SUPPRESSED and all charges are hereby DISMISSED.
