Blewitt v. Department of Transportation

License suspension appeal – *Nunc pro tunc* – Unreasonable delay in license suspension

- 1. An appeal from a license suspension must be made within thirty days of the mailing date of the suspension letter.
- 2. An appeal *nunc pro tunc* may be permitted upon showing that the delay in filing the appeal resulted from extraordinary circumstances involving fraud or breakdown of the court's operations, or non-negligent circumstances on the part of the appellant or his counsel.
- 3. Appeals *nunc pro tunc* may not be extended as a matter of grace or indulgence.
- 4. Without a sufficient basis for granting an appeal *nunc pro tunc*, the court lacks subject matter jurisdiction to entertain the matter and any attractiveness of arguments on the merits is of no moment because the tribunal is without power to grant the requested relief.
- 5. Where a licensee raises the defense of undue delay, the licensee must prove that (a) an unreasonable delay chargeable to the Department led the licensee to believe that his operating privilege would not be impaired, and (b) prejudice would result by having the licensee's operating privilege suspended after such delay. Once the licensee raises the delay defense, the Department must then prove that the delay was caused by some factor other than mere administrative inaction. If the Department meets this burden, the licensee's appeal should be dismissed. If the Department fails to meet its burden, then the burden shifts to the licensee to prove prejudice.
- 6. The petitioner's offense was in 1993; he was convicted in 1995; his suspension letters were dated in April, 2012. Petitioner does not know when he received the suspension letters but does not dispute the mailing dates. He placed the letters in his attorney's mailbox; apparently, the attorney did not receive the letters and at some point contacted the Department, whereafter the petition for appeal *nunc pro tunc* appeal was filed more than three months after the mail dates of the suspension letters. Petitioner did not demonstrate fraud, breakdown in the court's operations, or non-negligent conduct on his or his attorney's part. The Court found petitioner was careless in how he handled the receipt of the three notices which directly contributed to the delay in his filing. Thus, the Court *Held* the petition to appeal *nunc pro tunc* must be denied, regardless of the delay of the mailing of the suspension letters.

ORDER FOR DENIAL OF PETITION FOR APPEAL NUNC PRO TUNC

AND NOW, this 8th day of October, 2012, upon consideration of the Petition of Edwin John Blewitt for leave to file an appeal *nunc pro tunc* in this license suspension case, and after hearing held September 20, 2012, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that the prayer of the Petition is DENIED and the Petition is DISMISSED.¹

An appeal from a license suspension must be made within 30 days of the mailing date of the suspension letter. *Commonwealth, Department of Transportation v. Matlack*, 600 A.2d 998, 999 (Pa. Cmwlth. 1999) . An appeal *nunc pro tunc* may be permitted upon showing that the

¹The petitioner, Edwin John Blewitt filed an untimely appeal on July 27, 2012 from three letters from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, all dated April 2, 2012, suspending his operating privilege for a total of seven years. He filed a petition for appeal *nunc pro tunc*, which was heard on September 20, 2012. Mr. Blewitt testified that he did indeed receive the three suspension letters from the Department, and had no reason to dispute their mailing dates. However, he could not say when he received any of the letters from the Department. He testified that he placed the letters in his attorney's mailbox in the same envelopes in which he had received them. Apparently, the attorney did not receive the three letters and at some point he contacted the Department, whereafter the appeals were filed, as noted, on July 27, 2012.

delay in filing the appeal resulted from extraordinary circumstances involving fraud or breakdown of the court's operations, or non-negligent circumstances on the part of the appellant or his or her counsel. *Baum v. Commonwealth, Department of Transportation*, 949 A.2d 345 (Pa. Cmwlth. 2008). Appeals *nunc pro tunc* may not be extended as a matter of grace or indulgence. *Hudson v. Commonwealth, Department of Transportation*, 830 A.2d 594, 598 (Pa. Cmwlth. 2003). Without a sufficient basis for granting an appeal *nunc pro tunc*, the court lacks subject matter jurisdiction to entertain the matter. In that event, any attractiveness of arguments on the merits is of no moment because the tribunal is without power to grant the requested relief. *Robinson v. Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole*, 582 A.2d 857, 860 (Pa. Cmwlth. 1990).

Mr. Blewitt has not demonstrated fraud, breakdown in the court's operations, or non-negligent conduct on his or his attorney's part. He was careless in how he handled the receipt of the three notices which directly contributed to the delay in this case. His petition to appeal *nunc pro tunc* must thus be denied.

Ordinarily, that would be the end of the discussion. However, there was evidence of record that the date of the offense, driving under suspension, alcohol-related, occurred March 1, 1993. Mr. Blewitt was convicted of that offense over two years later, on September 20, 1995. Even more dramatic was the fact that his operator's privilege was suspended by letters dated April 2, 2012, over 16 years later. However, the reasons for the delay between the offense and conviction, and between the conviction and the suspension, were not admitted into evidence for the reasons set out in this opinion.

Petitioner Blewitt contends that 42 Pa. C.S.A. §5552(e) applies to license suspension cases and precludes the Department's tardy enforcement against him. He relies on *Commonwealth*, *Department of Transportation v. Gray*, 38 D & C 3d. 121 (Mont. Co. 1985). The court in *Gray* cited to a statute of limitations provision which provides that:

No proceedings shall be held or action taken pursuant to a summary offense under Title 75 subsequent to two years after the commission of the offense.

Unfortunately, the court in *Gray* inadvertently mis-cited this section, referring in its opinion to 42 Pa. C.S. §5552(e), not to 42 Pa. C.S. §5553(e). This error made its way into Mr.

Blewitt's memorandum of law. The court will presume that Mr. Blewitt meant to cite the two year limitation provision at §5553(e). Petitioner's main problem, however, remains that of the posture of this case, a petition to appeal *nunc pro tunc*. Even were this a timely appeal from a suspension or revocation of a license, such appeal being civil in nature, a reviewing court may not consider any claimed procedural defects or errors in the proceeding which formed the basis for the suspension or revocation; collateral attacks are not permitted. *Lewis v. Commonwealth, Department of Transportation*, 73 Pa. Cmwlth. 407, 458 A.2d 1053 (1983), *cert. den.*, 465, U.S. 1066, 104 S. Ct. 1416, 79 L.Ed. 2d. 742. The court in *Lewis* squarely held that §5553(e) does not preclude the Department from initiating a license suspension more than two years after the offense. *Accord, Commonwealth, Department of Transportation v. Danks*, 114 Pa. Cmwlth. 37, 538 A.2d 120 (1988).

More recently, the Commonwealth Court, in the case of *Cesare v. Commonwealth*, *Department of Transportation*, 16 A. 3d. 545 (Pa. Cmwlth. 2011), a case involving a timely statutory appeal, held that where a licensee raises the defense of undue delay, the licensee must prove that (1) an unreasonable delay chargeable to the Department led the licensee to believe that his operating privilege would not be impaired, and (2) prejudice would result by having the licensee's operating privilege suspended after such delay. Once the licensee raises the delay defense, the Department must then prove that the delay was caused by some factor other than mere administrative inaction, citing *Grover v. Commonwealth*, *Department of Transportation*, 734 A.2d 941, 943 (Pa. Cmwlth. 1999). If the Department meets this burden, the licensee's appeal should be dismissed. But if the Department fails to meet its burden, then the burden *shifts* to the licensee to prove prejudice, 16 A.3d at 549. The common pleas court decision in *Commonwealth*, *Department of Transportation v. Gray, supra*, must of course yield to these later pronouncements from the Commonwealth Court.

None of this helps this petitioner because his request to permit a late appeal has been denied.






